- Heavy duty polymer anchor holder with recess/divider for rope and chain {mounted inside locker}
- All wiring is marine tinned and all connections are made with epoxy coated heat shrink connectors
- All battery cable connections are made with solder and epoxy coated heat shrink
- Hull is bonded to deck/liner with structural adhesive and thru-bolted every 6”
- All empty chambers under cockpit floor are foam filled {closed cell}
